Citizens of Val Verde County

The Val Verde Sheriff's Office has been notified by a citizen who has been scammed of funds by the following method.

Caller Identified himself as Deputy James Marshall and advised the citizen that they needed to come up with \$1500.00 or risk arrest. Citizen was directed to get a money pack available at the Dollar General.

Scam caller had detailed knowledge of the subpoena process. Caller stated he worked for Sheriff Frank Martinez, that the office was located at 295 FM 2523 and that the fine was imposed because citizen failed to answer a subpoena summons at the courthouse on Pecan Street.

At no time does the Val Verde Sheriff's Office conduct business in this manner.

If any citizen receives this type of call don't comply with the callers demand for funds. Hang up and call the Val Verde Sheriff's Office at 830-774-7513.

Again, at no time does the Val Verde Sheriff's Office or any other Law Enforcement agency conduct business in the manner.
