1. Discussion and possible action to approve the postage meter lease renewal for the County Auditor's and the District Clerk's office for 60 months at \$84.95 per month each and authorize County Judge to sign agreement. These are priced through Sourcewell contract #011322-PIT.
2. Discussion and possible action to authorize County Judge to sign a contract from Reconyx to provide SIM cards and data/image forwarding services from Sheriff's cameras. Expenses incurred are a one-time \$1,000 set-up fee, an annual maintenance fee of \$1,000 and estimated monthly expenses of \$135. This is the most economical versus going through our cellular/hot spot carrier.
3. Discussion and possible action to authorize County Judge to sign the Hoopla Digital Media Agreement. The Hoopla platform allows libraries to provide their users with access to digital media content using various devices and web browsers; and offers various licenses to media content in multiple formats.


4. Discussion and possible action to award a proposal from DLP Services for the installation of fencing and a dugout at the Alcoa Baseball Field Improvements in the amount of \$259,604.00. Project will be funded from ARPA-Alcoa account and from ARPA-Parks& Fairgrounds as previously approved during a Commissioner's Court meeting on March 28, 2023.

5. Discussion and possible action to award AR6 Construction & Engineering the project to Renovate HVAC system for the Aerospace Physiology Facility at LAFB with alternative pricing options in the amount of \$864,874.00.

6. Discussion and possible action to approve a purchase of a John Deere 4075R Compact Utility Tractor with a rotary cutter in the amount of \$72,876.28 to be paid from Pct. 2's FEMA account and transferred into Pct.2's Capital Outlay. This is priced through Buy Board contract #611-20.

7. Discussion and possible action for approval to declare the following items as surplus property and designate for proper disposition. Disposition may include but not limited to being auctioned, transferred, recycled, and/or destroyed. (List included in packet)
