Val Verde County is accepting sealed bids from vendors to provide concrete material to construct a parking Lot to include driveways, curbs, gutters, and sidewalks for the Robert “Bob” Chavira Sports Complex in Del Rio, TX, 78840. The Val Verde County Purchasing Department will be accepting sealed bids until 2:00 P.M. on August 27, 2026 at 509 E. Gibbs St., Del Rio Tx, at which time and place will be publicly opened and read aloud.

It is the responsibility of the submitting entity to ensure that the bid is received in a timely manner. Any bid received after closing time will be returned unopened.

Bidders are invited to submit a bid for the following:

**Ready mix concrete 3,000 psi. No construction activities are proposed for this bid.
A separate bid has been prepared for labor.**

The material delivery site is located in Val Verde County, TX. Address 1926 Jap Lowe Dr.

Bidders may visit www.valverdecountry.texas.gov website to view and/or download bid documents, technical specifications, plans and drawings. If a different format is needed to download or print the plans, you may submit a request by emailing Mr. Carlos Velarde, P.E. cvelarde@valverdecountry.texas.gov. It is the responsibility of the Contractor bidding to use proper scaling, paper width and length, etc. Failure to do so may result in error in the bid amounts.

Bidders shall submit a bid bond by an acceptable surety in the amount of five percent (5%) of the bid issued with each bid for contracts greater than \$100,000.00. A certified check or bank draft payable to Val Verde County or negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (as par value) may be submitted in lieu of the Bid Bond.

The successful Bidder must furnish a Performance and a Payment Bond in the amount of 100% of the contract price from an approved Surety Company holding a permit from the State of Texas to act as Surety and acceptable according to the latest list of companies holding certificates of authority from the Secretary of Treasury of the United States, or other Surety or Sureties acceptable to the Owner, per State statute and if applicable.

Val Verde County reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding. Bids may be held by Val Verde County for a period not to exceed thirty (60) days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the bidders' qualifications prior to the contract award.

The successful bidder must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, sexual identity, gender identity, or national origin. All contractors and/or subcontractors who are debarred, suspended or otherwise excluded from or ineligible for participation on federal assistance programs may not undertake any activity in part or in full under this project.
