Val Verde County is accepting competitive sealed bids to construct a concrete parking lot at the future site of the Robert “Bob” Chavira Sports Complex located in Val Verde County, TX, 78840. This bid is for labor only and all material will be supplied by Val Verde County. The Val Verde County Purchasing Department will be accepting sealed bids until 2:00 P.M. on September 3rd, 2026 at 509 E. Gibbs St., Del Rio Tx, at which time and place will be publicly opened and read aloud. Any bid received after closing time will be returned unopened.

It is the responsibility of the Bidder to ensure that the bid is received in a timely manner.

Bidders may visit www.valverdecountry.texas.gov or www.civcastusa.com to view and/or download Bid documents, technical specifications, plans and drawings. If a different format is needed to download or print the plans, you may submit a request by emailing Mr. Carlos Velarde, P.E. cvelarde@valverdecountry.texas.gov. It is the responsibility of the Contractor bidding to use proper scaling, paper width and length, etc. Failure to do so may result in error in the bid amounts.

Bidders may submit questions about the project until **August 25, 2026 at 4:30 p.m.** All questions shall be received by email and shall be sent to Carlos Velarde, at cvelarde@valverdecountry.texas.gov. Questions may also be submitted in writing on CivCast's website at www.civcastusa.com. Responses will be provided to all prospective bidders via email and posted on both Val Verde County's website and Civcast's website by **August 28, 2026**.

A Bid Bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of the bid amount issued by an acceptable surety is required with each bid that exceeds \$100,000.00. A certified check or bank draft payable to Val Verde County or negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (as par value) may be submitted in lieu of the Bid Bond. **All Bid Bonds must contain original signatures.**

The successful Bidder must furnish Performance and Payment Bonds each in the amount of 100% of the contract price from an approved Surety Company holding a permit from the State of Texas to act as Surety and acceptable according to the latest list of companies holding certificates of authority from the Secretary of Treasury of the United States, or other Surety or Sureties acceptable to the Owner. Awarded contractor shall be required to furnish bonds within thirty (30) days of the contract date but before any commencement of work.

The County reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids and to waive formalities. In case of ambiguity in stating the price in the bid, the County reserves the right to consider the most advantageous construction thereof or to reject any bids. Also, the County reserves the right to accept the low bid based on the tabulation of anyone, combination or all the base bid(s), alternate bid(s) and/or, optional bid(s) based on the most advantageous project bid that is desired by the County involved and that the County in their sole judgment determines is the County's best interest and benefit. Bids may be held by Val Verde County for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of reviewing and investigating the bidder's qualifications prior to the contract award.

The successful bidder must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, sexual identity, gender identity, or national origin. All contractors and/or subcontractors who are debarred, suspended or otherwise excluded from or ineligible for participation on federal assistance programs may not undertake any activity in part or in full under this project. Val Verde County is an Affirmative Action/Equal Opportunity Employer. Section 3 Residents, Minority Business Enterprises, Small Business Enterprises, Women Business Enterprises, Labor Surplus Area Firms and any other applicable disadvantaged businesses including HUBs are encouraged to submit bids.
