63rd District Court Procedures to file a Writ of Habeas Corpus:

- 1) Writ of Habeas Corpus will include magistration paperwork, Order Setting Hearing and Personal Data Sheet. After all documents received, the Court will set the matter for hearing.
- 2) The Court will request a Bond Report from Pretrial Services.
- 3) A Hearing date will be assigned and a copy of the Order Setting Hearing will be provided to the State of Texas and the Attorney of Record for Defendant.
- 4) If the applicant has been released prior to the Writ Hearing, the Applicant's Attorney will file a Notice of Nonsuit and Order of Nonsuit to dispose of the pending Writ of Habeas Corpus.
- 5) If the Court grants the Bond Reduction, please use the Sample Order Reducing Bond below.
