Baseball Field and Perimeter Fencing

Val Verde County is soliciting request for proposals from contractors for services to construct a baseball field area of approximately 52,500 square feet and a perimeter fencing area of approximately 895.50 linear feet complete with, but not limited to, laying sod, leveling and spreading red clay sand at Long Memorial Park, 1176 Lenawee Avenue, Del Rio Tx, 78840.

Offerors shall submit a proposal bond by an acceptable surety in the amount of five percent (5%) of the proposal in excess of \$100,000.00. A certified check or bank draft payable to the locality or negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (as par value) may be submitted in lieu of the Proposal Bond.

The successful offeror must furnish Performance and Payment Bonds each in the amount of 100% of the contract price from an approved Surety Company holding a permit from the State of Texas to act as Surety and acceptable according to the latest list of companies holding certificates of authority from the Secretary of Treasury of the United States, or other Surety or Sureties acceptable to the Owner. Awarded contractor will be required to furnish bonds within thirty (30) days from the contract date and before any commencement of work.
